Ramblings from the Rectory

I've been watching a royal wedding. I was spell bound by it all: The spectacle, the drama and the excitement were infectious. It was so amazing that it didn't really matter that it wasn't my queen getting married. The whole occasion was very different from a British royal wedding but none the less for that. This whole occasion was for me made even more wonderful by the fact that, apart from my wife, I was the only human being watching it all!

I wasn't watching a human wedding, I was watching the mating flight of a queen bee. The princes (drones) were piling out of my hives to chase the new queen. Some of the worker bees carried on working but many buzzed around in circles, excitedly waiting to see the bride. And the queen? Those who have gone through divorce can become cynical about relationships in general and marriage in particular. But I seek to reassure that God wants to heal their hurt and sense of failure. God wants to reassure them of forgiveness for anything that they might have done wrong so that they are truly free to live and love again.

I wish all couples who are newly married, or looking forward to their marriage, every blessing, now and in their future together. I also wish God's blessing on all couples, particularly those with children, whether married or not. Being a husband, wife, partner or a parent is all hard to do well. I pray that the Holy Spirit will bless and protect all couples and families here in our community, that they will know His comfort and support, His love and His joy, now and always.


