October is a time for autumn colours, perhaps the most beautiful time of year, especially in woodland. Since I was a small child I have loved walking through autumn woods. I remember longing for them to fall so that I could kick my way through them. Those autumn colours are at least as exuberant as the bursting of life that marks spring. Each season has its beauty and its joy. I hope that you manage to get out and enjoy the beauty, and the autumn taste to the air, whether this turns out to be a dry or a wet October. Warm or cold autumn is a spectacle not to be missed.

For me any walking out in the natural world is an act of worship. So walking out in an autumn woodland is worship cubed! In this love of the natural world I remember the great northern saints like Columba and Aiden. They are often pictured with creatures resting on them or by their feet. I remember St. Francis too, who is celebrated on 3<sup>rd</sup> October. One of the treasures that Francis discovered was the presence of God in all creation. Through all that has corrupted and marred in this world Francis could still see the craftsman's hand. This was a very radical view in the early 13<sup>th</sup> Century but Francis' obvious devotion to God convinced the church that he was a prophet not a heretic.

So this October, as we long to leave Covid behind I share with you one verse and the chorus of a song associated with St. Francis. He almost certainly didn't write it but it sums up his thought so well. It is a prayer for our relationships together with one another, and our relationships with the natural world:

Make me a channel of your peace Where there's despair in life, let me bring hope Where there is darkness, only light And where there's sadness, ever joy.

Oh, Master grant that I may never seek So much to be consoled as to console To be understood as to understand To be loved as to love with all my soul.

Enjoy the autumn beauty of October.
