CURATE'S CURIOSITY

Since the run up to the US election in 2016 I have had a fascination with US politics. Actually, not so much a fascination, so much as a slow-motion sense of rubbernecking at the horror story of a democratic nation

electing one of the least suitable persons to the highest office. I have uttered frequent disbelief at the lies, the arrogance, the lack of personal morals, the incompetence and the chaos.

Back in the early 2000s there was a US television series called the West Wing, brilliantly written and superbly acted by an ensemble cast led by Martin Sheen as the fictional US president. This was a hugely charismatic former economics professor who built a strong team of brilliant advisers around him. What was most notable was that it was the portrayal of a leader with deep integrity and character. Willing to do the right, but unpopular thing. To weigh the situation. To set his goals beyond simply reelection in four years time. This was the kind of series in which every episode made you feel stupid by comparison with these characters — and yet cleverer too, because this programme raised your levels of thinking, your sense of humour, and your positivity. Every time I watch an episode, I am reminded how fundamental deep integrity is to real leadership.

Recently the US president has caused outrage by a series of openly racist speeches and tweets, condemning now whole cities. Democrats and black American leaders have expressed their outrage, but there has been too little outrage from his own party — or American Christians.

But this trend was bucked on 30th July when Washington National Cathedral published a statement of condemnation, asking 'Where is our country's sense of decency?... When does silence become complicity?'

I was relieved to see such a clear statement from such a major church in the US. About time, too.

To stand with them, and echo their dissension, let me add that Christ's love was and is equally for all, without exception, and that Christians should affirm this. God loves all people, of all colour and nation, young or old, rich or poor, gay or straight, cool or nerd, saint or sinner — and regardless of any other means by which we so often group and categorize people.

Our churches in this benefice welcome all people, too. Whether you are 'church' or 'unchurched', faith or no faith, inquiring or not interested, you matter. You are welcome.

And racism, bigotry and hate are wrong, no matter who it is.
