Faith Through the Fire

A month ago, as we all know, St John's, our church in Harleston, was badly damaged by fire. It left us feeling shocked and sad as we mourned the loss of a place that has seen decades of worship, Celebrations, Remembrance Services, laughter and prayer; but, even in the midst of our sadness and regret, we remember one truth that remains unshaken - **our God is faith-ful.**

We have seen evidence of that in the days since the fire - the church is not built with wood or stone, but with *people*—living testimonies of God's grace. The same Spirit that filled our church still fills our hearts. The same God who met us there still meets us wherever we are.

The apostle Paul wrote in 2 Corinthians 4:8–9: "We are hard pressed on every side but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed."

We've seen God's goodness to us in countless ways with neighbours reaching out to us, churches offering help and 'St Thomas More Chapel' allowing us to worship in their building on a Sunday. Volunteers continue to give their time; professionals work and plan for our restored church and prayers rise from every corner. These are the signs of God's hand at work among us.

We may have lost one of our church buildings, temporarily, but we have *not* lost our purpose or 'whom we are'. Our church will continue to be a light in our community and across the Benefice, perhaps, shining even brighter than before. The flames that damaged our building haven't destroyed our passion for worship, love and service, nor our desire to proclaim God's faithfulness and glorify His name. We are Christians together, a family, united, and full of hope—because our foundation is Christ, and He will never fail.

As we look ahead, we hold on to the words of Isaiah 61:3, that God will give us, "beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness." What was lost does not define us; rather, how we respond—with faith, unity, hope and gratitude—will be our true testimony. So, we move forward together, trusting that God will bring beauty from these ashes, and that the best days of St John's and our Benefice are still to come. **Amen**


